Call to Order: Sarah called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

Vice President's Report: Mike created an updated advertisement for the Herald for elections. Sarah liked this idea, and Karen Emmons will research the breakout.

Sarah would like the survey questions final by Monday, 8/22.

It was also suggested that the Board work to solicit ads from companies we all see working in the community, and also canvass in person Twinbrook shopping center and University Mall.
