Fall Festival – Helen brought up how we can use the Festival to incentivize membership. We agreed to table this for the time being.

**Pro-Rating of Dues:** Helen suggested a way to pro-rate dues by offering discounted membership for the year following if dues were paid late in the year. Alan asked how many people this would affect. Discussion was tabled until later.

**Board Positions:** We need an at-large board member, and will need a new VP by summer. President encouraged the board to think about neighbors who might be interested; Meri noted that there is a fair amount of admin relating to the Boy Scouts, so a Scout parent might be ideal.
