### **Eggstravaganza:**

We decided that the raffles would be for KPW members only –people will be able to sign up to be a member at the event. Meri and Helen offered to help Pamela put together treat bags. The boy scouts usually handle the egg hunt – they’re unavailable this year, so Meri will send out an email to block captains asking for volunteers to help stuff and hide eggs. Meri will also ask Cathy re the possibility of getting Girl Scouts to help with the egg hunt.

Meri proposed giving money to Cathy to help defray Eggstravaganza costs. Helen suggested writing a check from the non-line-item part of the budget – Meri will email Alan and propose giving \$500 to Cathy.

### **Membership meeting:**

Helen raised concerns as to how many people are getting our emails, and about extending invitations to the virtual membership meeting and how we could do this. We confirmed that the meeting will be 6-7pm, and decided that Supervisor Walkinshaw should kick off, and also give time for attendees to ask him questions. Meri noted that she wanted to talk to members about getting involved in volunteering, and Helen discussed her vision for a slide deck, with different personas showing different levels of involvement.

**Other Business:**

Pool Sponsorships: Meri will send out emails to each pool regarding getting the ball rolling on pool sponsorships for this summer.
