The concern is that we need community support to get anything passed – we can recommend a fewer number of speed bumps. In the next steps, we'll need signed permission from all homeowners immediately next to the proposed devices, and then FCDOT will lead a community meeting. Later, during the voting phase, over 50% of homeowners in the balloting area must agree ("Yes" vote). Rose will write an article for the next Herald citing data.
